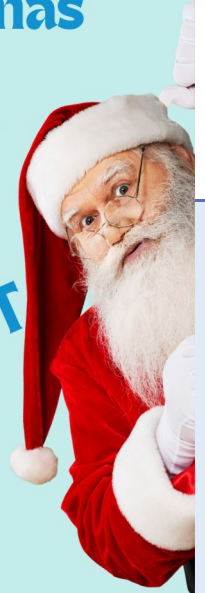

### Boyer Mountain—Phase I Approved; Next Phases Under Review

In August 2025, after several public meetings and discussion with Boyne Mountain, the Planning Commission approved an initial phase of the resort's plans for a new eco-resort campus north of the Boyne River including new rental cabins (Lushnas, ridge houses, and treehouses) and related hiking paths. The Commission is now reviewing the next phase between Addis Road and the Boyne River that includes a farm-to-table restaurant, a spa, and additional small "hamlet" lodging clusters. These items are subject to Planning Commission review and public input; no decisions have been made on later phases.

### Crooked Tree District Library
